## **Swatara Watershed Park Rules and Regulations**

- One camper (rv/ travel trailer/popup) or tent per campsite. Trailers must be licensed and road worthy.
   Campsites are generally to the left of the yellow numbered tags. Camper must be parked perpendicular to the road, if the site allows.
- 2. Two (2) vehicles per campsite. Additional vehicles may park on the main lot to the west of the entrance. No parking on grass around the office and pavilion, cars will be towed.
- 3. No generators or ATVs are allowed on the site. No discharge of firearms.
- 4. SWA is not responsible for informing campers of impending flood events, however, if directed by the site manager, all gear must be removed prior to a predicted flood event. Trailers may be moved to higher ground as designated by the site manager. Campers are responsible for moving their own camper/trailer. Extreme flooding events will require trailers to be removed from the premises.
- 5. The first 15 feet from the Swatara Creek is for public walkway or fishing.
- 6. One picnic table is supplied per campsite. The camper is responsible for securing the table to a tree to avoid loss prior to a flood. Stacking of items on top of a table prior to a flood is not permitted, as the items may be washed into the creek during a flood. Campers will be charged for recovery and/or replacement.
- 7. One fire ring is supplied per campsite. Fires must be contained in a ring.
- 8. No buildings or structures of any kind are permitted.
- Under no circumstances shall wood with nails be brought onto the property. To control invasive species, imported firewood must be from within a 50-mile radius. No cutting of live trees. Downed trees may be used for firewood.
- 10. No discarding or planting of any non-native plant species.
- 11. Campers are responsible for cleaning/mowing their own campsite. No equipment is provided.
- 12. All units, garbage and gear must be removed from the property by November 1. If not, a nonrefundable \$50 disposal surcharge will be assessed, and must be paid in full prior to the next camping season.
- 13. Campers must take their garbage home weekly.
- 14. Pets must be leashed on your lot. No more than two dogs per campsite. Excessive barking will not be tolerated. All dog waste must be picked up and disposed of in the trash.
- 15. Drugs and alcohol are prohibited.
- 16. For environmental purposes, no dishwashing detergent may be discharged onto the ground.
- 17. No washing of vehicles. The 5 mph speed limit must be obeyed at all times.
- 18. Self-contained units must use their own sewerage system. No dumping of waste in porta john.
- 19. Per East Hanover Township ordinance, all units must leave the premises at least once every thirty(30) days.
- 20. Prior to setting up a site, campers must sign a liability release form and read the 2024 Notice to Campers.
- 21. No excessive noise. Quiet hours are between 11 PM and 6 AM.
- 22. Only official flags of the United States of America, Pennsylvania, Lebanon County, the armed forces and/or POW MIA may be flown at the campsites. All other flags will be removed.

Persons in violation of any rules and regulations may be evicted without reimbursement of their donation.
